A Guide to Hard Drives for Final Cut Pro

Firewire hard drives for Final Cut Pro should conform to these specifications:

- 7200 RPM drive
- Oxford 911 chipset (*some* Oxford 922 chipsets will work)
- Firewire 400 (6 pin) connector

Here at NewTV, we have tested and confirmed the following models will work. Others may work, but we can not guarantee success as they are untested.
